Key matches: Opening match + 6 total matches
City vibe: Football temple, unforgettable energy
Pro tip: Use Uber, metro can be very crowded

Guadalajara
Stadium: Estadio Akron (48,071 capacity)
Key matches: 4 group stage matches
City vibe: Mariachi music, tequila, tradition
Pro tip: Visit Tlaquepaque for crafts

Monterrey
Stadium: Estadio BBVA (51,000 capacity)
Key matches: 3 group stage + 1 knockout match
City vibe: Industrial city, passionate fans
Pro tip: Try local craft beer scene

Stadium: BMO Field (45,000 capacity)
Key matches: 5 group stage + 1 knockout match
City vibe: Multicultural, clean, efficient
Pro tip: Easy day trip to Niagara Falls

Dallas

Stadium: AT&T Stadium (80,000 capacity)
Key matches: Semifinal + 8 total matches
City vibe: Texas hospitality, massive screens
Pro tip: Stadium has AC - welcome relief from summer heat

Atlanta

Stadium: Mercedes-Benz Stadium (42,500 capacity)
Key matches: Semifinal + 8 total matches
City vibe: Southern charm, great food scene
Pro tip: MARTA train goes straight to stadium

San Francisco Bay Area

Stadium: Levi's Stadium (68,500 capacity)
Key matches: 5 group stage + 1 knockout match
City vibe: Tech innovation, diverse culture
Pro tip: Stadium is in Santa Clara, not San Francisco

Boston

Stadium: Gillette Stadium (20,000 capacity)
Key matches: 5 group stage + 2 knockout matches
City vibe: Sports history, passionate locals
Pro tip: Take commuter rail from South Station

Kansas City

Stadium: Arrowhead Stadium (76,416 capacity)
Key matches: 4 group stage + 2 knockout matches
City vibe: BBQ capital, friendly Midwest vibe
Pro tip: Tailgating is a must-do experience

New York / New Jersey

Stadium: MetLife Stadium (82,500 capacity)
Key matches: Final (July 19) + 5 other matches
City vibe: Global melting pot, endless options
Pro tip: Use NJ Transit trains, avoid driving to games

Los Angeles

Stadium: SoFi Stadium (70,240 capacity)
Key matches: USA group stage + 7 total matches
City vibe: Celebrity sightings, perfect weather
Pro tip: Metro rail is your friend, traffic is terrible

Miami

Stadium: Hard Rock Stadium (64,767 capacity)
Key matches: 3rd place match + 6 total matches
City vibe: Latin flair, beaches, nightlife
Pro tip: It's hot and humid - dress accordingly

Seattle

Stadium: Lumen Field (37,722 capacity)
Key matches: 4 group stage + 2 knockout matches
City vibe: Passionate supporters, coffee culture
Pro tip: Experience local supporter pubs

Philadelphia

Stadium: Lincoln Financial Field (71,896 capacity)
Key matches: 5 group stage + 1 knockout match
City vibe: Underdog spirit, historic sites
Pro tip: Walkable downtown, great food scene

Houston

Stadium: NRG Stadium (72,220 capacity)
Key matches: 5 group stage + 2 knockout matches
City vibe: Space City, amazing food diversity
Pro tip: Use park-and-ride services for games
